ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) Temporary Waiting Restrictions West Temple Sheen, East Sheen

(Ref 15/047)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate deliveries to be made to Sheen Mount Primary School, they will introduce temporary waiting restrictions in West Temple Sheen, East Sheen.
- 2. From Tuesday 17 March 2015 until Friday 20 March 2015 between 9.30am and 2.30pm and between 4.00pm and 5.00pm, and on Saturday 21 March 2015 between 8am and 1pm no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in West Temple Sheen, from a point outside the common boundary of Nos 1 and 3 West Temple Sheen southwards to a point 20 metres north of its junction with Westhay Gardens.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 17 March 2015 at 9.30am. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 5. The temporary waiting restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 9.30am on 17 March 2015 and remain in force for 5 days Should the works extend beyond this period the closure will be continued in force by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs and cones.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
