ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Sheen Gate Gardens, East Sheen

(Ref: 15/055)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate a gas connection to be undertaken to a property they will introduce a road closure in Sheen Gate Gardens, East Sheen
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed wait or stand in Sheen Gate Gardens from the eastern kerb-line of Firs Avenue, eastwards to a point outside the eastern flank wall of No 19 Sheen Gate Gardens.
- 3. A diversion route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Sheen Lane, Upper Richmond Road West and Sheen Gate Gardens.
- 4. The restrictions will come into force on 7 April 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 6. The temporary closure will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 7 April 2015 and remain in force at all times until 11 April 2015, that is, for a period of 5 days. Should the works extend beyond this date, the Council will continue in force the provisions of this Notice with an Order made under Section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
