- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Whilst this Order continues in force the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) Order 1994(c), as amended, shall apply as if
 - (a) the amendments as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order were made to the Articles numbered 4, 5, 6 and 7 of that Order as a consequence of adding Schedule 28 as provided by Paragraph (b) below;
 - (b) there were added to the Articles in the Schedules, Designated loading places list as follows 'Schedule 28 1 hour loading place between 7.00am and 10.00am,on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
 - (c) there were added to that order a new schedule being Schedule 28 and the item numbered 28/1 and as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 2 to this order

Designation of loading places

4. Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, Schedule 2, Schedule 3, Schedule 4, Schedule 5, Schedule 6, Schedule 7, Schedule 8, Schedule 9, Schedule 10, Schedule 11, Schedule 12, Schedule 13, Schedule 14, Schedule 15, Schedule 16, Schedule 18, Schedule 19, Schedule 20, Schedule 21, Schedule 23, Schedule 24, Schedule 25 or Schedule 26 and, unless otherwise specified, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 2.5 metres is designated as a loading place.

Vehicles for which loading places are designated

5. Each loading place referred to in Schedule 1, Schedule 2, Schedule 3, Schedule 4, Schedule 5, Schedule 6, Schedule 7, Schedule 8, Schedule 9, Schedule 10, Schedule 11, Schedule 12, Schedule 13, Schedule 14, Schedule 15, Schedule 16, Schedule 18, Schedule 19, Schedule 20, Schedule 21, Schedule 23, Schedule 24, Schedule 25, Schedule 26, Schedule 27 or Schedule 28 may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, during the permitted hours for the leaving of goods vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicles.

Period for which a vehicle may be left in a loading place

6. No person shall cause any vehicle to be left in a loading place designated by Schedule 1, Schedule 2, Schedule 3, Schedule 5, Schedule 6, Schedule 7, Schedule 9, Schedule 10, Schedule 11 or Schedule 19 or Schedule 20 for a continuous period of more than twenty minutes or in a loading place designated by Schedule 2, Schedule 4, Schedule 8, Schedule 12, Schedule 13, Schedule 15, Schedule 16, Schedule 18, Schedule 21, Schedule 23, Schedule 24, Schedule 25, Schedule 26, Schedule 27 or Schedule 28 for a continuous period of more than one hour or in a loading place designated by Schedule 14 for a continuous period of more than two hours.

Contravention in loading places

7. If a goods vehicle is left in a loading place designated by Schedule 1, Schedule 3, Schedule 5, Schedule 6, Schedule 7, Schedule 9, Schedule 10, Schedule 11, Schedule 19 or Schedule 20 for a continuous period of more than twenty minutes or in a loading place designated by Schedule 2, Schedule 4, Schedule 8, Schedule 12, Schedule 13, Schedule 15, Schedule 16, Schedule 18, Schedule 21, Schedule 23, Schedule 24, Schedule 25, Schedule 26, Schedule 27 or Scheduke 28 for a continuous period of more than one hour or in a loading place designated by Schedule 14 for a continuous period of more than two hours a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. If a vehicle other than a goods vehicle is left in a loading place designated in any of the Schedules previously referred to in this Article during the permitted hours, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.


