# DISABLED PERSONS PARKING BAYS VARIOUS STREETS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH

(Reference 15/070)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The principal objective of the Order is to introduce a number of parking places for disabled persons where a high level of parking makes reasonable means of access difficult, to relocate an existing parking place and to discontinue a number of similar parking places previously provided where the demand for such bays no longer exists.
- 3. The Order will introduce a parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles, operating "at any time" in the following streets:

Alexandra Road, Kew;
Clarendon Crescent, Twickenham;
Clonmel Road, Teddington;
Cotswold Road, Hampton;
Edwin Road, Twickenham;
Kings Road, Teddington;
Mill Farm Crescent, Whitton;
Moor Mead Road, Twickenham;

Murray Road, Ham; Oldfield Road, Hampton; Palmers Road, East Sheen; Rectory Grove, Hampton; Seymour Road, Hampton Wick; Vale Close, Twickenham and Watermill Close, Ham.

- 4. The Order will relocate located in the vicinity of No 38 Mead Road Ham to be relocated to outside No 21/23 Mead Road, Ham.
- 5. The Order will revoke the existing parking bay for disabled persons' vehicles in the vicinity of each of the following locations:

90 Buckingham Road, Hampton; 75 Hall Farm Drive, Twickenham; 33 Houblon Road. Richmond and 18 Shen Park, Richmond.

- 6. Copies of the proposed Order, plans showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order:-

Com and	Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the missioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as ended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—
1.	This Order shall come into operation on **************** and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (People with Disabilities)

- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
  - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
  - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (People with Disabilities) Order 2007(c), as amended, shall have effect as though
  - (a) there were added to the items in Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered 5D, 41B, 44B, 44C, 48C, 62E, 123D, 158B, 161B, 163A, 166B, 178C, 106C, 214A and 259B as set out in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
  - (b) there were substituted for the item numbered 184 the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
  - (c) the items numbered 26, 97, 158A and 218B in Schedule 2 to that Order set out in columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Schedule 3 to this Order were revoked.

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

Under delegated powers additional parking bays are proposed to be introduced for the exclusive use of Blue Badge holders who meet the criteria approved by the Transport Sub-Committee on 22 July 1996 and for any other vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge issued by a Local Authority.

The bays are situated:-

- (i) outside No 62 Alexandra Road, East Kew;
- (ii) outside No 1 Clarendon Crescent, Twickenham;
- (iii) outside No 56 Clonmel Road, Teddington;
- (iv) outside No 15 Clive Road, Twickenham;
- (v) outside No 18 Gerard Road, Barnes;
- (vi) outside No 7 Cotswold Road, Hampton;
- (vii) outside No 3 Edwin Road, Twickenham;
- (viii) outside No 25 Kings Road, Teddington;
- (ix) outside No 19 Mead Road, Ham;
- (x) outside 45 Mill Farm Crescent, Whitton;
- (xi) outside No 3 Moor Mead Road, Twickenham;
- (xii) outside No 25 Murray Road, Ham:;
- (xiii) outside No 137 Oldfield Road, Hampton
- (xiv) opposite Palmers Passage in Palmers Road, East Sheen;
- (xv) outside No 32 Rectory Grove, Hampton:
