

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporay Suspension of Bus Lane -  
Castelnau, Barnes**

(Reference 15/071)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate bus stop accessibility works they will temporarily suspend a bus lane in Castelnau, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place, vehicular traffic will be permitted to proceed In the north-east bound bus lane in Castelnau which runs from the common boundary of Nos 5 and 7 Castelnau to a point 3 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos 171 and 173 Castelnau where directed by signs and a taper.
3. The provisions of this notice will come into force at 9.30am on 21 April 2015. It is anticipated that the suspension will remain in force until 4pm on that day.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
5. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 21 April 2015 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
6. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
