

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions  
Mereway Road, Twickenham**

(Reference 15/126)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas service works, they will introduce temporary waiting restrictions in Mereway Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Mereway Road on its north-eastern side from a point outside the common boundary of Nos 43 and 45 Mereway Road south-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.
3. The provisions of this notice will come into force on 20 July 2015. Further details of the dates and times of the restrictions are contained in Paragraph 5.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on Monday 20 July 2015 and remain in force between 8am and 5pm daily until Friday 24 July 2015, that is, for a period of 5 days, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
6. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
