

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Road Closure
The Retreat, East Sheen**

(Ref: 15/127)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency gas main works they will introduce a road closure in The Retreat, East Sheen.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed wait or stand in The Retreat, East Sheen.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 20 July 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 20 July 2015 and remain in force at all times until 24 July 2015, that is, for a period of 5 days. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
