

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Road Closure Denbigh Gardens, Richnond

(Reference 15/128)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the likelihood of danger to the public and the need to repair a collapsed sewer they will introduce a temporary closure in Denbigh Gardens, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed wait or stand in Denbigh Gardens from a point outside No 6 Denbigh Gardens to a point outside No 17 Denbigh Gardens.
3. The provisions of this notice will come into force on 20 July 2015. Further details of the dates of the closure are contained in Paragraph 6
4. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure shall be via Marchmont Road, Kings Road and Spring Grove Road, and vice versa.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 20 July 2015 and remain in force at all times for 21 days, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. The works are anticipated to be in progress until 31 July 2015
7. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
