## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Waiting Retractions Castle Yard, Richmond

(Reference 15/132)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate building works, they will temporarily introduce a waiting restriction in Castle Yard, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Castle Yard on its south-eastern side, from a point 3 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Lewis Road south-westwards for a distance of 5 metres.
- 3. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 27 July 2015 and remain in force for a period of 5 days. After this time, the provisions of this Notice will be continued in force until 3 July 2016 by means of an Order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Nothing in the notice applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
