

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Suspension of Bus Lane -
London Road, Twickenham**

(Reference 15/133)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate street lighting maintenance works they will temporarily suspend the bus lane in London Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, all vehicular traffic will be permitted to proceed in the bus lane in London Road, Twickenham on its north-eastern side, from a point 25 metres south-east of the northern boundary of No 2 Cole Park Road, Twickenham to a point 101 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Arragon Road.
3. The suspension will come into force at 9.30am on 29 July 2015. It is anticipated that the suspension will remain in place until 3.30pm on that day.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
5. The measures described will be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 29 July 2015 and remain in force until the works are complete, or for a period of 5 days, whichever is the shorter. They may be extended by an order made under section 14(1) of the said Act.
6. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
