

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A

Temporary Road Closures – Little Green and Quadrant Road, Richmond

(Reference 15/140)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that on 3 August 2015 to facilitate the holding of a Red Carpet Event at Richmond Theatre and to facilitate filming, they made a. temporary order, the effects of which are to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Little Green and Quadrant Road, Richmond
- To facilitate the holding of the event, Little Green and Quadrant Road will be closed to vehicular traffic on the dates and times detailed in the Schedule to this Notice. The one-way working in Quadrant Road will be suspended to facilitate local access. A signed diversion for vehicles affected by the closures will be available, via adjacent streets.
- 3. The provisions of this Order will not apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said event; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, any person authorised by the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames or a civil enforcement officer.
- 4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENT) (BAFTA CELEBRATION EVENT) ORDER 2015

Made: 3 August 2015

Comes into operation: 10 August 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the traffic authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads within the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") is satisfied that an event, the particulars of which are given in Article 2 of the following order, should be held on certain parts of the borough roads and that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and parking restricted in order to facilitate the holding of that event and to enable members of the public to watch that event.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 10 August 2015 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Special Event) (BAFTA Celebration Event) Order 2015 and shall remain in force for 3 days.

The Event and Interpretation

- 2. (1) The event for which this order makes provision is the BAFTA Celebration of Downton Abbey at Richmond Theatre;
 - (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"specified day" means the day specified in column 2 of any item of the Schedule;

"restricted street" means the street named in column 3 of any item of the Schedule subject to such limitation as may be specified in column 4 of any such item; "restricted hours" in relation to any restricted street means the hours specified in column 5 of any item in the Schedule;

"Schedule" means the Schedule to this Order.

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

- 3. Whilst the Order remains in force:
 - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand, in any restricted street on any specified day during the restricted hours;
 - (b) Item 3 of the Schedule to the Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (No.
 1) Order 1973(b) shall be suspended the effect being that two-way working will be permitted in Quadrant Road to allow vehicles exempted from the provisions of the road closure to be able to enter and exit Quadrant Road.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said event or to any utility vehicle.
- 5. Nothing in this order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, civil enforcement officer or person authorised by the Council;
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion;
 - (c) any vehicle requiring access to, or exit from, the underground car park at 4 Little Green.
- 6. The provisions of this order will only apply during such times when it is necessary or expedient to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in the road(s) or length of road(s) specified in Article 3 of this order and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c), as amended.

Contravention

7. If a vehicle is left during the restricted hours without complying with the requirements of this order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004(d) may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of the said Act.

Manner of payment of the penalty charge

8. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as provided for by Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011(e).

Alteration of position of/or removal of vehicles

9. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this Order, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may, under the provisions of

the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986(f), as amended, remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.
