

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions  
Mereway Road, Twickenham**

(Reference 15/146)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate maintenance works to be undertaken to a weir, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Mereway Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Mereway Road, the south-west to north-east arm, from its junction with Mereway Road (north-west to south-east arm), north-eastwards for a distance of 60 metres.
3. The order will come into effect on 31 August 2015. The restrictions will be in force from 31 August 2015 until 11 September 2015 between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
