ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Grosvenor Road, Twickenham

(Ref: 15/177)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate sewer repair works they will introduce a road closure in Grosvenor Road, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Grosvenor Road from a point 20 metres north-west of the common boundary of Nos 8 and 10 Grosvenor Road to a point 20 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos 8 and 10 Grosvenor Road.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 9 October 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. A signed alternative route will be available for vehicles via adjacent streets.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 9 October 2015 and remain in force at all times until 13 October 2015, that is, for a period of 5 days, after which the Council will make an Order under Section 14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
