

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Road Closure
Thames Street and Upper Sunbury Road, Hampton**

(Reference 15/182)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water main repairs and highway maintenance they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Thames Street and Upper Sunbury Road, Hampton.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Upper Sunbury Road and Thames Street, between their junctions with Lower Sunbury Road and High Street, Hampton.
3. The order will come into effect on 13 November 2015. The restrictions will be in force from 7pm on 13 November until 8pm on 15 November 2015, from 7pm on 20 November 2015 until 8pm on 22 November and from 7pm on 27 November until 8pm on 29 November 2015, whilst signs are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. Signed diversions for traffic affected by the closure will be available via adjacent streets.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
