ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Restrictions Percy Road, Hampton, Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 12 November 2015 made a temporary Traffic Order to facilitate Network Rail to undertake works on the level crossing at Hampton. The effect of the Order is that vehicular traffic is not permitted to proceed over the level crossing in Percy Road, Hampton and parking suspensions operate in Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton.
- Due to the need for additional works to be undertaken, it has been necessary to reintroduce the provisions of the Order on the following dates: 18-19 June 2016 -22:00-08:00; 19-20 June 2016 - 22:00-04:30; 25-26 June 2016 - 22:00-08:00; 26-27 June 2016 - 22:00-04:30; 15-16 July 2016 - 22:00-05:30; 23-24 July 2016 - 16:00-20:00; (28 hours continuous); 30-31 July 2016 - 22:00-07:00; 20-21 August 2016 -22:00-05:30; 21-22 August 2016 - 22:00-04:30; 27-28 August 2016 - 22:00-05:30 and 28-29 August 2016 - 22:00-04:30.
- 3. Whilst the works take place during the dates and times detailed in Paragraph 2 above, .no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Percy Road, Hampton between its junctions with Ashley Road and Station Road. These restrictions will apply when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
- 4. During the dates and times detailed in Paragraph 2 above, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in:
 - a. Ashley Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Percy Road and Milton Road;
 - b. Station Approach, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Ashley Road and Tudor Road;
 - c. Milton Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junction with Ashley Road and the party wall of Nos. 72 and 74 Milton Road;
 - d. and where relevant signs and cones are placed.
- 5. Whilst the Hampton Level Crossing in Percy Road is closed an alternative route for traffic will be via Ashley Road, Station Approach, Tudor Road and Station Road in both directions. Access to residents will be maintained.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

Temporary Road Closure Percy Road, Hampton

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton

(Reference 15/188)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to facilitate essential maintenance works on Hampton level crossing they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a road closure in Percy Road, Hampton and waiting restrictions in Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Percy Road, Hampton between its junctions with Ashley Road and Station Road. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed. The Order will come into force on 1 December 2015.
- 3. Between 7pm on 1 December 2015 and 5.30am on 2 December and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in:
 - a) Ashley Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Percy Road and Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed,
 - b) Station Approach, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Ashley Road and Tudor Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed; or
 - c) Milton Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junction with Ashley Road and the party wall of Nos. 72 and 74 Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed.
- 4. The road closure will be in force from 11.30pm on 1 December 2015 until 5.30am on 2 December 2015 and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015.
- 5. Whilst the Hampton Level Crossing in Percy Road is closed an alternative route for traffic will be via Ashley Road, Station Approach, Tudor Road and Station Road in both directions. Access to residents will be maintained.
- 6. The works are anticipated to be in progress overnight from 11.30pm on 1 December 2015 until 5.30am on 2 December 2015 and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 7. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.

- 8. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 9. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

Temporary Road Closure Percy Road, Hampton

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton

(Reference 15.188)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to facilitate essential maintenance works on Hampton level crossing they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a road closure in Percy Road, Hampton and waiting restrictions in Ashley Road, Station Approach and Milton Road, Hampton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Percy Road, Hampton between its junctions with Ashley Road and Station Road. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed.
- 3. Between 7pm on 1 December 2015 and 5.30am on 2 December and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in:
 - a) Ashley Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Percy Road and Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed,
 - b) Station Approach, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Ashley Road and Tudor Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed; or
 - c) Milton Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junction with Ashley Road and the party wall of Nos. 72 and 74 Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed.
- 4. The road closure will be in force from 11.30pm on 1 December 2015 until 5.30am on 2 December 2015 and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015.
- 5. Whilst the Hampton Level Crossing in Percy Road is closed an alternative route for traffic will be via Ashley Road, Station Approach, Tudor Road and Station Road in both directions. Access to residents will be maintained.
- 6. The works are anticipated to be in progress overnight from 11.30pm on 1 December 2015 until 5.30am on 2 December 2015 and again at the same times overnight on 2/3 December 2015 and 3/4 December 2015. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 7. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Nothing in the Order applies to:

- (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;

- (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- 9. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.



TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (HAMPTON LEVEL CROSSING, HAMPTON) ORDER 2015

Made: 12 November 2015

Comes into operation: 1 December 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and car parking restricted in order to facilitate works on the level crossing in Percy Road (hereinafter referred to as "the works"):

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 December 2015 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Hampton Level Crossing, Hampton) Order 2015 and shall remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months).

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

- 2. Whilst the works takes place no person may cause any vehicle to proceed in Percy Road, Hampton between its junctions with Ashley Road and Station Road. These restrictions will apply at any time and when prescribed traffic signs are displayed. The closure will come into force at 11.30pm on 1 December 2015 until 5.30am on 2 December 2015 and again at the same times overnight on 2 and 3 December 2015 and 3 and 4 December 2015.
- 3. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait in:-
 - (a) Ashley Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Percy Road and Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed,
 - (b) Station Approach, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junctions with Ashley Road and Tudor Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed; or
 - (c) Milton Road, Hampton the waiting restrictions will apply between its junction with Ashley Road and the party wall of Nos. 72 and 74 Milton Road or where relevant signs and cones are placed.

The parking suspension will come into force at 7pm on 1 December 2015 and 5.30am on 2 December and again at the same times overnight on 2 and 3 December 2015 and 3 and 4 December 2015.

4. Nothing in Article 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle connected with the execution of the said works or to any public service or utility vehicle.

- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply:
 - to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform (a) or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or (b) police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.
- The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times when it is necessary to 6. prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in that road or length of road and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

Contravention

If a vehicle is left during the restricted time without complying with the requirements of this 7. Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004(c) may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of that Act.

Manner of payment of the penalty charge

The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as set out in Schedule 2 to the London 8. Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011(d).

Alteration of position or removal of vehicles

Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this Order, a civil 9. enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may, under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986(e), as amended, remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.
