- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 12 November 2015 made the above mentioned Order under sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order is to introduce lengths of waiting restrictions in Kilmorey Road as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.
- 3. Full details of the Order, which will come into operation on 23 November 2015, are contained in the following documents:-
 - (a) the Order;
 - (b) a plan indicating the location and effect of the restrictions; and
 - (c) the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order.

until the date on which the Order ceases to have effect.

- 5. This Order provides that in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Director of Environment of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, or other person authorised in that behalf by that officer may, if it appears to that officer or to that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.
- 6. If the provisions of this Order continue in operation for a period of not less than six months, the Council will consider in due course whether the its provisions should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1984. Persons wishing to object to or support the making of such an Order for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation in force may, within the period of six months referred to above send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds of that objection to the address below.

requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 23 November 2015 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (No.9) Experimental Order 2015.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though for the item numbered 373 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 4. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Director, of Environment of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, as the specified officer, or some person authorised in that behalf by that officer may, if it appears to that officer or to that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

There is a 5 metre length of double yellow line near its junction with St Margarets Road and lengths of single tallow line operating between 10am and noon on Mondays to Fridays inclusive on the north-eastern and north-western side of Kilmorey Road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (No. 9) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2015

Following the introduction of the extension to the S2 Parking Scheme in St Margarets North, and a new S3 Parking Scheme, this Order introduces waiting restrictions in lengths of Kilmorey Road, Isleworth to address issues of access caused by parked vehicles displaced from these new parking schemes.

This scheme is being introduced on an experimental basis to give the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames powers to make modifications or variations to the scheme in the light of operational experience.

The Council will consider in due course whether to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of this Order.
