

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Suspension of One-Way Working
Holly Road, Twickenham**
(Reference 15/203)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate deliveries to a construction site they have made a temporary Traffic Order the effect of which is to introduce a temporary suspension of one-way working in Holly Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place the one-way working operating in Holly Road between its junctions with Queens Road and Copthall Gardens shall be suspended.
3. The order shall come into effect on 30 November 2015 and continues in force the provisions of a Notice made under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which came into force on 23 November 2015. The works are anticipated to be in progress until 2 September 2016. The provisions of the order will be in force Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 6pm inclusive where relevant signs/cones are placed. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. The suspension applies only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

**Temporary Suspension of One-Way Working
Holly Road, Twickenham**

(Reference 15/203)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate deliveries to a construction site they will introduce a suspension of one-way working in Holly Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, the one-way working operating in Holly Road between its junctions with Queens Road and Copthall Gardens shall be suspended
3. The provisions of this notice will come into force on 23 November 2015. Further details of the dates of the closure are contained in Paragraph 5.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
5. This suspension will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 23 November 2015 and remain in force between 8am and 6pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for 5 days, after which the Council will make an Order under S14 (1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
6. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE WAY WORKING) (HOLLY ROAD, TWICKENHAM) ORDER 2015

Made: 26 November 2015

Comes into operation: 30 November 2015

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the Highway Authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads in the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, are satisfied that vehicular traffic should be prohibited and car parking restricted in order to facilitate deliveries to be made to a construction site (hereinafter referred to as "the works"):

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30 November 2015 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Suspension of One-Way Working) (Holly Road, Twickenham) Order 2015 and shall remain in force for 18 months. The works are anticipated to be in progress from 30 November 2015 until 2 September 2016.

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

2. Whilst the works take place, between 8am and 6pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive. Item 2 of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (One Way Traffic) (Twickenham Town Centre) Order 2014(b) shall be suspended, the effect being that the one-way working operating in Holly Road, Twickenham between its junctions with Queens Road and Copthall Gardens shall be suspended.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle connected with the execution of the said works or to any public service or utility vehicle.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion, provided that conditions which prevail on site at any one time do not render it unsafe or

impossible for such a vehicle or vehicles to use any part of the public highway for the time being.

5. The provisions of this Order will only apply during such times when it is necessary to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in that road or length of road and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).
