

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Waiting Restriction
Bicester Road, Richmond**

(Ref: 15/207)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate the installation of a camera they will introduce a temporary waiting restriction in Bicester Road, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Bicester Road on its southern side from the western kerb-line of Bicester Road, westwards to a point outside the common boundary of Nos 5 and 6 Bicester Road.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 25 November 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restriction are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 7am on 25 November 2015 and remain in force until 29 November 2015 that is, for a period of 5 days. The works are expected to be in progress between 7am and 9am on 25 November 2015 only.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
