

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Road Closure
The Terrace and Elm Bank Gardens, Barnes**

(Ref: 15/211)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to a building collapse and the need to clear the site they will introduce a road closure in Elm Bank Gardens and The Terrace, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place
 - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in The Terrace from its junctions with Lonsdale Road and High Street, Barnes to its junction with Mortlake High Street;
 - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Elm Bank Gardens.
3. A diversion for traffic will be available via Castelnau, Rocks Lane, South Circular Road, Clifford Avenue, Lower Richmond Road and Mortlake High Street. Local access will be maintained when possible
4. The restrictions will come into force on 26 November 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 26 November 2015 and remain in force at all times until 30 November 2015, that is, for a period of 5 days. If the works are required to continue beyond this time, the Council will make an Order under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice until the works are completed.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
