ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) Temporary Road Closure Crown Road, Twickenham

(Reference 15/214)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency repairs to a void in the carriageway they will introduce a road closure in Crown Road, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person may permit a vehicle to enter or proceed in Crown Road, Twickenham between its junctions with Richmond Road and St Margarets Road. Local access will be maintained wherever possible.
- 3. The provisions of this notice will come into force on 30 November 2015. Further details of the dates of the closure are contained in Paragraph 6.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure will be available via Richmond Road and St Margarets Road.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 30 November 2015 and remain in force at all times until 4 December 2015, that is for a period of 5 days after which time the Council will continue In force the provisions of this Notice by making a Notice under S14(1) of the said Act for a period of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 7. The restriction will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
