NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames proposes to install a speed table in Sandycombe Road, Kew at its junctions with Lichfield Road and High Park Road, extending into Station Parade.

The speed table will be sited in Sandycombe Road from a point 20 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Lichfield Road extending northwards to a point 29 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Lichfield Road, extending into Lichfield Road from the western kerb-line of Sandycombe Road, for a distance of some 8 metres, and extending into High Park Road for a distance of some 30 metres with an extension into Station Parade from the eastern kerb-line of High Park Road for a distance of some 7 metres. All the lengths include ramps, which have a gradient of 1:20.
