Temporary Footpath Closure PRW 60 which links Gipsy Lane and Queens Ride, Barnes

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency tree cutting works they will introduce a footpath closure of the public right of way which links Gipsy Lane and Queens Ride, Barnes.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in PRW No 60 which links Gipsy Lane and Queens Ride, Barnes. Access will be maintained where possible.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 10 December 2015. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 10 December 2015 at 9.30am and remain in force until 1pm on 10 December 2015.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
