NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames proposes to install a speed table in Boileau Road and Madrid Road, at their junctions with Washington Road, with the table extending into Washington Road.

The speed table will be sited in Madrid Road from a point approximately 6 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Washington Road extending north-eastwards into Boileau Read to a point approximately 5 metres north-east of the north-western kerb-line of Washington Road, extending into Washington Road from the north-western kerb-lines of Boileau Road and Madrid Road, for a distance of approximately 6 metres, and extending into Washington Road from the south-eastern kerb-lines of Boileau Road and Madrid Road for a distance of approximately 6 metres. All the lengths include ramps, which have a gradient of 1:20.
