ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Banned Turn Broom Road, Teddington

(Ref: 16/090)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to emergency water main repair works, and due to the likelihood of danger to the public they will introduce a banned turn in Broom Rod, Teddington.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a north-easterly direction in King Edward's Grove, upon reaching its junction with Broom Road to turn right.
- 3. An alternative route for traffic will be available via Broom Road, Broom Water and Broom Road (north-eastern arm which links Broom Water and Broom Road, south-western arm).
- 4. The restrictions will come into force on 9 May 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 9 May 2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 21 days. The works are expected to be completed by 12 May 2016.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
