## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

## Temporary Parking Suspension Hanworth Road and Powder Mill Lane, Whitton

(Ref: 16/120)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need for emergency sewer repair works, and the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce a temporary pronation of traffic in Hanworth Road and Powder Mill Lane, Whitton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of street:-
  - (a) Hanworth Road, Whitton, the south-eastern side, from a point outside No 674 Hanworth Road to a point outside No 686 Hanworth Road;
  - (b) Powder Mill Lane, the south-western side, from a point 15 metres south east of its junction with Hanworth Road to a point adjacent to the south-eastern boundary wall of No 243 Powder Mill Lane (footway parking bays).
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 16 June 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 16 June 2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 21 days. Should the works continue beyond this date, the Council shall continue in force the provisions of this Notice with an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
