ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Mullins Path, Mortlake

(Ref: 16/137)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to carry out highway maintenance works, they will introduce a temporary restriction of traffic in Mullins Path, Mortlake.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Mullins Path. The works will be carried out on a rolling basis and access will be maintained where possible.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 4 July 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. A signed diversion for traffic will be available via adjacent streets.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Notice shall come into effect on 4 July 2016 and remain in force for a period of 5 days, that is, until 8 July 2016. Should the works continue beyond this date, the Council shall continue in force the provisions of this Notice with an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
