The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to introduce a length of single yellow lime operating between 7am and 7pm throughout the week on both sides of Sandy Lane, Teddington from a n point outside the common boundary of Nos 14 and 16 Sandy Lane to a point outside the rear of the south-eastern boundary of Nos 181-186 Harrowdene Gardens.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and these may come from residents, Councillors, Council officers or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THIS ORDER

The waiting restrictions will prevent obstructive parking along the affected length of Sandy Lane during the day and at road junctions and other sections of Sandy Lane at all times to ensure sight lines are maintained.
