

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Banned Turn
Hazel Close, Twickenham**

(Ref: 16/184)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate gas main repair works, they will introduce a banned turn in Hazel Close, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a northerly direction on the southern arm of Hazel Close, upon reaching the junction of the southern east to west arm to turn right.
3. An alternative route for traffic will be available by turning left at the junction of the southern east to west arm and north to south arm and proceeding clockwise.
4. The restrictions will come into force on 17 August 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 17 August 2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 5 daysm that is until 21 August 2016. If the works continue beyond this time, the Council will make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
