

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions for Cab Rank Kew Road, Kew

(Ref: 16/191)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to facilitate a cab rank for Kew the Movies and due to the possibility of danger to the public, they will introduce a temporary cab rank in Kew Road, Kew
- 2. Whilst Kew the Movies takes place, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Kew Road, on its north-western side, from the north-western extremity of the crossing control area outside Victoria Gate, north-eastwards for a distance of 75 metres except for hackney carriages (to facilitate a temporary cab rank).
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 7 September 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 7 September2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 2 days that is until 8 September 2016.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
