

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

**Temporary Footpath Closure  
Footpath Under Barnes Railway Bridge – Adjacent to The  
Terrace, Barnes**

(Ref: 16/210)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to emergency bridge repair works, and due to the likelihood of danger to the public they will introduce a closure of the footpath which runs under Barnes Railway Bridge adjacent to the River Thames and The Terrace, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall proceed in the footpath which runs under Barnes railway bridge from a point 2 metres north-east of the railway bridge to a point 10 metres south-west of the railway bridge (footpath No. 55).
3. An alternative route for pedestrians will be available via The Terrace.
4. The restrictions will come into force on 28 September 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used, or any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used, or any person needing access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 28 September 2016 and remain in force at all times for a period of 21 days. After this time, the Council will introduce an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to six months.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
