ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Manor Road, Richmond

(Ref: 16/223)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate emergency level crossing maintenance works, they will introduce a road closure in Manor Road, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to proceed in Manor Road between its junctions with Manor Grove and Manor Park.
- 3. Whilst Manor Road is closed, an alternative route for traffic will be via Manor Road, Upper Richmond Road West, Clifford Avenue, Lower Richmond Road and Manor Road in both directions.
- 4. The restrictions will come into force on 6 October 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 03.00 on 6 October 2016 and remain in force until 06.00 on 7 October 2016.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
