

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Suspension of One Way Working
Cumberland Road, Kew**

(Ref: 16/250)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate a large vehicle movement, they will introduce a temporary suspension of the one-way working in Cumberland Road, Kew.
2. Whilst the works take place Item 2(a) of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Cumberland Road and Leybourne Park) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1990 (1990/46) shall be suspended, the effect being that the one-way working in Cumberland Road, Kew will be suspended.
3. The restrictions will come into force on 30 November 2016. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 30 November 2016 and remain in force between 6am and 3pm on 30 November 2016 and 2 December 2016.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
