Temporary Waiting Restrictions Priests Bridge, Sheen

(Ref: 17/022)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water main repair works and due to the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce a waiting restriction in Priests Bridge, Sheen.
- Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Priests Bridge, from a point ousted No 18 Priests Bridge to a point outside No 26 Priests Bridge.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 24 January 2017. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 24 January 2017 and remain in force at all times for a period of up to 21 days. Should the works continue beyond this time the Council will introduce an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to eighteen months.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
