ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Waitinng Restriction Waldegrave Road, Teddington

(Ref: 17/044)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the need to facilitate access to a site by a large vehicle, they will introduce a waiting restriction in Waldegrave Road, Teddington.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Waldegrave Road the south-west side from a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of No 73 Waldegrave Road north-westwards to a point opposite No 79/81 Waldegrave Road.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 12 March 2017. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14.(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 6am on 12 March 2017 and remain in force for 5 days. The works are expected to be completed by 6pm on 12 March 2017. Should the works continue beyond 5 days, then the provisions of the Notice will be continued in force by an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
