

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Waiting Restrictons
High Street, Whitton
(Reference 17/063)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a water construction they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in High Street. Whitton.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of street:-
 - (a) High Street, Whitton, from a point outside No 11 High Street, Whitton to a point outside No 31 High Street, Whitton;
 - (b) High Street Whitton from a point outside the northern boundary of Nos 38 – 48 to a point outside the common boundary of Nos 50 and 52 High Street, Whitton.
3. The order will come into effect on 7 May 2017. The restrictions will be in force between 9am and 5pm on 7 May 2017 only and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
