Temporary Footpath Closure Trinity Cottages and Trinity Road, Richmond

(Ref: 17/075)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate footway repair works, they will introduce a footpath closure between Trinity Road and Trinity Cottages
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall enter or proceed in the footpath which links Trinity Road and Trinity Cottages.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 10 May 2017. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 4. An alternative route for anyone affected by the closure will be available via Trinity Road and Bardolph Road.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 10 May 2017 and remain in force at all times for a period of 5 days. Should the works continue beyond this time the Council will introduce an Order made under S14 (1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to six months. It is expected the works will be completed by 12 May 2017.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
