ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions High Street, Hampton Hill

(Ref: 17/079)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a temporary bus stop, they will introduce a waiting restriction in High Street, Hampton Hill.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall wait or stand in High Street, Hampton Hill on its north-western side, from a point outside the south-western boundary of No 169 High Street, Hampton Hill to a point outside the common boundary of Nis 171a and 171b High Street, Hampton Hill.
- 3. The restrictions will come into force on 17 May 2017. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
- 4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; and(d) buses.
- 5. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 17 May 2017 and remain in force at all times for a period of 5 days. Should the works continue beyond this time the Council will introduce an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to six months. It is expected the works will be completed by 31 May 2017.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
