

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Parking Suspension
Alder Road, Mortlake
(Reference 17/099)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate building works,, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Alder Road, Mortlake.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Alder Road, om its western side, from a point outside the northern boundary of No 36 Alder Road, northwards for a distance of 27 netres, that it is to say to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 15 and 17 Alder Road.
3. The order will come into effect on 3 July 2017. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 3 July 2017 until; 8 September 2017 and he order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until works are completed to the bridge. The restrictions will apply at such times and to such an extent as indicated by signs/cones.
4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
