

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

## Temporary Road Closure Denbigh Gardens, Richmond

(Ref: 17/105)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate a crane operation, they will introduce a waiting restriction in Denbigh Gardens, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed wait or stand in Denbigh Gardens between a point outside the common boundary of Nos 23 and 24 Denbigh Gardens, to a point outside the common boundary of Nos 25 and 26 Denbigh Gardens.
- 3. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure shall be available via Marchmont Road, Kings Road and Soring Grove Road and vice versa,
- 4. The restrictions will come into force on 19 July 2017. Further details regarding the dates and times of the restrictions are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 19 July 2017 and remain in force between 08.00 and 17.00 on that day only. After this time the Council will introduce an Order made under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for some additional days and back up days.
- 7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
