## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary Road Closure Dean Road and Rectory Grove, Hampton

(Reference 17/127)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Dean Road and Rectory Grove, Hampton..
- 2. Whilst the works take place,
  - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Dean Road from its junction with Dean Road to a point outside No 19 Dean Road;
  - (b) no person shall cause or [permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Rectory Grove from its junction with Dean Road for a distance of 15 metres.
- 3. The order will come into effect on 31 July 2017. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 31 July 2017 until 26 August 2017 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closures shall be available via Hanworth Road, Loxley Road and Rectory Grove and via Dean Road, Hanworth Road and Loxley Road.
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
