

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

Temporary Road Closure Grange Road, Barnes

(Reference 17/139)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate electrical cable installation works they have made a temporary Traffic Notice, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Grange Road, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Grange Road between its junctions with Gerard Road/Melville Road and Westmoreland Road. Local access will be maintained.
3. The Notice will come into effect on 17 August 2017. The restrictions will be in force at all times on 17 and 18 August 2017 only and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
4. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure shall be available via Gerard Road, Lowther Road and Westmoreland Road and vice versa.
5. Nothing in the Notice applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
