

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Waiting Restrictions Langham Road, Teddington

(Reference 17/146)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the likelihood of danger to the public arising from obstructive parking, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Langham Road, Teddington.
2. Whilst the Order remains in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand on the north-eastern side of Langham Road, from the northern kerb-line of the west to east arm of Kingston Lane north-westwards for a distance of 15 metres
3. The order will come into effect on 29 August 2017. The restrictions will be in force at all times and the order will remain in force for a period of 18 months.
4. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
