

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 14 (1) and 15(2)

## **Temporary Road Closure, Waiting Restrictions and Parking Provision Beauchamp Road and Mary's Terrace, Twickenham**

(Ref: 17/165)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate construction works to be undertaken at Twickenham Station, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is introduce restrictions to traffic in Beauchamp Road and Mary's Terrace, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place,
  - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Mary's Terrace from a point at the rear of No 70 London Road to a point on the south-western side of the London Road bridge;
  - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand at any time in Mary's Terrace from a point outside the common boundary of Nos 1 and 2 Mary's Terrace to a point 15.5 metres north-west of a point opposite the north-west facing wall of Nos 17 and 19 Beauchamp Road;
  - (c) the existing permit parking places sited on Marys Terrace 12 metres south-west of the south-western boundary wall of 16 Mary's Terrace, south-westwards for a distance of 10 metres will be converted to residents only parking places and re-positioned.
4. The order will come into effect on 2 October 2017. The Order will be in force at all times from 2 October 2017 until 30 June 2020 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. The Council is satisfied that the works will take longer than 18 months and the Council shall revoke the order when the works are completed if earlier than 30 June 2020.
5. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
