ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A Temporary Road and Footpath Closures Chestnut Avenue and Priory Road, Hampton

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate filming on the public highway, they have made a temporary Order, the effect of which is to introduce restrictions in Chestnut Avenue and Priory Road, Hampton
- 2. Whilst the filming is in progress, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in the following lengths of road:-
 - (a) Priory Road, from the eastern kerb-line of Percy Road, Hampton to the western kerb-line of Milton Road;
 - (b) Chestnut Avenue, from the northern kerb-line of Priory Road, northwards to a point outside the southern boundary of No 12 Chestnut Avenue.
- 3. The Order will come into effect at 9.30am on 3 October 2017 and remain in force until 7pm on that day. The roads will be open between 3pm and 4pm.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Percy Road, Holly Bush Road and Tudor Road
- 5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the filming;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (PRIORY ROAD, HAMPTON) (FILMING) ORDER 2017

Made: 28 Se[tember 2017

Comes into operation: 3 October 2017

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the traffic authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads within the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") is satisfied that traffic should be restricted to enable a filming event to take place.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 3 October 2017 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Priory Road, Hampton) (Filming) Order 2017 and shall remain in force for one day only.

The Event and Interpretation

- 2. (1) The event for which this order makes provision is a filming event in Priory Road, Hampton;
 - (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"restricted hours" means between 9.30am and 3.00pm and between 4.00pm and 7.00om and these hours shall apply on the day of the event only.

"police community support officer" means a person who has been so designated by the Metropolitan Police Service as provided for by Section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002(b), and

"accredited person" means a person who has been accredited by the Metropolitan Police Service under the Community Safety Accreditation Scheme as provided for by Section 41 of that Act;

and in either case whilst exercising the powers of a police community support officer or an accredited person that person is wearing an approved uniform as provided for by Section 42(2) of that Act.

Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic

- 3. During the restricted hours, and at such times and to such an extent as indicated by traffic signs, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in the following lengths of road:
 - (a) Priory Road, from the eastern kerb-line of Percy Road, Hampton to the western kerb-line of Milton Road;
 - (b) Chestnut Avenue, from the northern kerb-line of Priory Road, northwards to a point outside the southern boundary of No 12 Chestnut Avenue
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said event or to any utility vehicle.
- 5.. Nothing in this order shall apply:
 - (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform, civil enforcement officer, police community support officer or an accredited person.
 - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
- 6. The provisions of this order will only apply during such times when it is necessary or expedient to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in the road(s) or length of road(s) specified in Article 3 of this order and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(c), as amended.

Alteration of position of/or removal of vehicles

7. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this order, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Contravention

8. If a vehicle is left during the restricted hours without complying with the requirements of this order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004(d) may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of the said Act.

Manner of payment of the penalty charge

9. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as provided for by Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011(e).
