

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Parking Suspension  
Fitzgerald Road, Mortlake**

(Reference 17/176)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works, they intend to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Fitzgerald Road, Mortlake.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Fitzgerald Road, Mortlake.
3. The restrictions will come into effect on 2 October. The restrictions will be in force at all times for 5 days. After this date, the Council will make an Order to continue in effect the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months. The works will be carried out on a rolling basis and the prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
4. Nothing in the Notice applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
