ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Road Closure Duke Street and The Square, Richmond

(Reference 17/194)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate electric cabling works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Duke Street and The Square, Richmond.
- 2. Whilst the works take place,
 - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Duke Street between its junction with George Street and Quadrant Road;
 - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in The Square on the southern side of the island site, from the south-eastern kerb-line of George Street westwards for a distance of 15 metres.
- 3. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the closures will be available via Quadrant Road, The Quadrant and The Square, and via The Quadrant, Kew Road, Twickenham Road and The Quadrant.
- 4. The order will come into effect on 22 November 2017. The restrictions will be in force from 9.00am on 22 November 2017 until 5.30pm on 23 November 2017 and whilst signs/cones are in place. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
