

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary One-Way Working Suspension
Church Street, Twickenham**

(Ref: 18/054)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate water main repairs, they will suspend the one-way working in Church Street, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place, Item 2 of the Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Routes) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1975 (b) shall be suspended, the effect being that Church Street will operate with two-way traffic flow.
3. The Notice will come into force on 21 February 2018. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 5 of this notice.
4. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The temporary Notice will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect at 9.30am on 21 February 2018 and remain in force at all times for a period of 5 days or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works should take longer than 5 days then the Council will make a temporary Traffic Order under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months. The works are expected to be completed by 23 February 2018.
6. The Notice will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
