



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions  
Richmond Park Road, East Sheen**

(Reference 18/112)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate filming on the public highway, they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Richmond Park Road, East Sheen.
2. Whilst the filming is taking place, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Richmond Park Road, on its north-western side, from a point outside No 76 Richmond Park Road to a point outside the common boundary of Nos 54/56 Richmond Park Road.
3. The order will come into effect on 14 May 2018. The restrictions will be in force between 8am and 6.30pm on 14 May 2018 and at the same time for a further four days until 6.30pm on 18 May 2018.
4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

## **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER**

### **THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (FILMING) (RICHMOND PARK ROAD, EAST SHEEN) ORDER 2018**

Made: 10 May 2008

Comes into operation: 14 May 2008

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") being the traffic authority for all streets within the said London borough, with the exception of those streets which are part of the Transport for London Road Network and those which are Crown roads within the Royal Parks of Richmond Park and Bushy Park, (hereinafter referred to as "the borough roads") is satisfied that traffic should be restricted to enable filming take place.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Commencement and citation**

1. This Order shall come into operation on 14 May 2018 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Filming) (Richmond Park Road, East Sheen) Order 2018 and shall remain in force for 5 days.

#### **The Event and Interpretation**

2. (1) The event for which this order makes provision is a filming event in Richmond Park Road, East Sheen;
- (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"restricted hours" means between 8am and 6.30pm from 14 May 2018 until 18 April 2018 inclusive.

#### **Prohibition or restriction of vehicular traffic**

3. During the restricted hours, no person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in Richmond Park Road, on its north-western side, from a point outside No 76 Richmond Park Road to a point outside the common boundary of Nos 54/56 Richmond Park Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said event or to any utility vehicle.

5. Nothing in this order shall apply:
- (a) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or civil enforcement officer;
  - (b) to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
6. The provisions of this order will only apply during such times when it is necessary or expedient to prohibit or restrict vehicular traffic in the road(s) or length of road(s) specified in Article 3 of this order and to such extent as is at the time indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016**(b)**, as amended.

**Alteration of position of/or removal of vehicles**

7. Where any vehicle is standing in contravention of the provisions of this order, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

**Contravention**

8. If a vehicle is left during the restricted hours without complying with the requirements of this order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice showing the information required by the Traffic Management Act 2004**(c)** may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer in accordance with the requirements of the said Act.

**Manner of payment of the penalty charge**

9. The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council as provided for by Schedule 2 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Manner of Payment of Penalty Charges) Order 2011**(d)**.
