

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

## Temporary Road Closure Amyand Park Road, Twickenham

(Ref: 18/181)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate essential works at St Margarets Station, they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Order to restrict traffic in Amyand Park Road, Twickenham.
- 2. Whilst the works take place,
  - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Amyand Park Road between its junctions with St Margarets Road and Beaconsfield Road;
  - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Amyand Park Road between its junctions with St Margarets Road and Bridle Lane.
- 3. An alternative out for vehicles affected by the closure will be available via Beaconsfield Road and St Margarets Road. Access to Bridle Lane will be maintained from the south-western end of Amyand Park Road.
- 4. The order will come into effect on 29 September 2018. The restrictions will be in force from 00.01 on 29 September 2018 until 02.00 on 1 October 2018 and again from 00.01 on 13 October 2018 until 02.00 on 15 October 2018. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
- 5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
