

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2) (b)

Temporary Restrictions Alexandra Road, Morley Road and Richmond Road, Twickenham

(Ref: 18/216)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency sewer repair works to be undertaken and due to the likelihood of danger to the public, they will introduce temporary restrictions in Alexandra Road, Morley Road and Richmond Road, Twickenham
2. Whilst the works take place,
 - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to exit Morley Road at its junction with Richmond Road;
 - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Morley Road between its junctions with Richmond Road and Alexandra Road;
 - (c) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in Alexandra Road to such an extent as indicated by signs/cones;
 - (d) the one-way working in Morley Road between its junctions with Richmond Road and Alexandra Road shall be suspended;
 - (e) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the parking bays on the south-eastern side of Richmond Road, from a point opposite a point 1.3 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos 362 and 364 Richmond Road north-eastwards for a distance of 15.5 metres.
3. Signed diversions for traffic affected by the closure will be available via Alexandra Road and Richmond Road.
4. The restrictions will come into force on 4 October 2018. Further details regarding the dates and times of the closure are explained in paragraph 6 of this notice.
5. Nothing in this Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The temporary restrictions will be introduced by a notice given under Section 14(2) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The notice will come into effect on 3 October 2018 and remain in force for 21 days or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. After this time the Council will make a temporary Traffic Order under S14(1) of the said Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for up to 18 months. The works are expected to be completed by 31 October 2018.
7. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.

8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
